Each immersion suit has a unique product number. You can find this number on the DOC (Declaration of Conformity), which is included with the invoice that is delivered with each immersion suit shipment.

Scandia's DOC contains the following information:

- Name/address of manufacturer
- Model and/or serial number of equipment
- List of relevant directives
- List of applicable standards (including amendments and effective dates)
- Declaration statement
- Certificate number
- Name, address, and number of the Notified body responsible for certification
- Name and position of signee
- Signature
- Date
